EDUCATE



- Discover and define yourself.
- What do you want to do? What are you doing?
How do you want to be known?
- Use Custom Objectives with forethought.



COMMUNICATE



- Buy-In: Communication fosters cooperation and enthusiasm.
- Everyone can have a part to play.



NAVIGATE



- Best of both: customized AND field-tested objectives
- Seed steps: Build success progressively. VMAP is YOUR development tool.
- Steering committee (2nd and 3rd officers) AND charged agents



EVALUATE



- How do you define and measure progress? When and where? How do you know you're progressing?
- Responsible agent (Champion)
- Monitor regularly, course correct as necessary (navigate!).
